Toilet facilities - useful information

Using toilets when travelling on TfL services

The map shows the location of public toilets across the TfL rail and Tube network, categorised by whether they are located outside or inside the ticket gates. Toilets which are shown as outside the ticket gate may not be within the station itself but in a nearby National Rail station or bus station. Please check the adjacent list. Some toilets shown on this map are not managed by TfL, indicated by the [†]. These may have a charge for use and may be closed at certain times of day. Please contact the operator for further details about these facilities. Some toilets shown on this map are within bus stations managed by TfL, rather than stations, indicated by the [*]. All TfL toilets are free to use. Where possible, toilets are open throughout the day. However, at some stations they may be closed at certain times of the day, especially later in the evening. If you need to use a toilet and find it locked, please speak to a member of staff who will give you access as long as it is possible to do so. Some toilet facilities may be unavailable when Night Tube services are operating if they are in a part of the station that is closed. RADAR locks are provided on some accessible toilets. If you do not have a RADAR key, station staff will be able to give you access to the toilet.

The majority of baby changing facilities are available to both male and female carers.
